

J.B. and Hallie Jester Williamson County Annex

History Behind the Jester Annex

In July 2009, an estimated 410,686 people lived in Williamson County, an increase of more than 160,000 since 2000, or 64.3 percent. According to the U.S. Census Bureau, Williamson County is ninth among the fastest-growing U.S. counties with populations of at least 10,000, and second in the State of Texas.

With this tremendous growth defined, the County responded in a proactive manner by moving toward a centralized location for the services provided in the Round Rock annex, the county's oldest annex building, having served the community for more than 20 years. By conducting an important feasibility study to determine the impact additional annex traffic might generate, and to analyze any environmental constraints, as well as other concerns, the current site plan was selected for a new annex.

Following recommendations to locate the new J.B. and Hallie Jester Annex on its current site, the county purchased the 25-acre tract from the Bradley Family Trust in January 2007. By October of 2007, the Commissioners Court selected Moman Architects to design the plans for the buildings. Chasco Constructors was later selected as the construction manager. A groundbreaking was held for the annex on April 23, 2009, with construction complete by April, 2010.



The main building has been named the J.B. and Hallie Jester Williamson County Annex, in honor of the Jester family who has a long-standing history in the area of Round Rock, Texas. The property on which the new annex stands was owned by Joseph Bailey Jester and his wife Hallie Bradley Jester and has been in the family since the late 1800s until Williamson County purchased the land. Joseph Bailey Jester, a lifelong resident in Round Rock, was the grandson of Texas Ranger Captain Nelson Merrell, who owned more than 1,000 acres of land from Highway 79 (then a dirt road) northward to Old Settler's Boulevard. Hallie Bradley Jester, wife of Bailey Jester, was also a lifelong resident of Round Rock. She worked at the Round Rock Cheese Factory and served as secretary and bookkeeper for Round Rock I.S.D. for 16 years.

Unique Annex Attributes

The Jester Annex is comprised of 29,000 square feet and showcases the offices of the Precinct One Commissioner, Justice of the Peace, and Constable. The Tax Assessor/Collector's Round Rock Office also is located in the new annex and is the first in the county to offer dual-lane drive through windows for ease in paying property taxes and vehicle registrations. A large community room, which includes a warming kitchen for public meetings, is included. The meeting room is available for rental to the county's citizens for non-profit and other group use. An additional smaller building, approximately 6,500 square feet, houses an Emergency Medical Services (EMS) substation as well as a Sheriff's Office substation.

Location and Directions

The address for the J.B. and Hallie Jester Annex is 1801 E. Old Settler's Boulevard, approximately one mile east of Interstate Highway 35, just past Sunrise Boulevard on the south side of Old Settler's Boulevard.



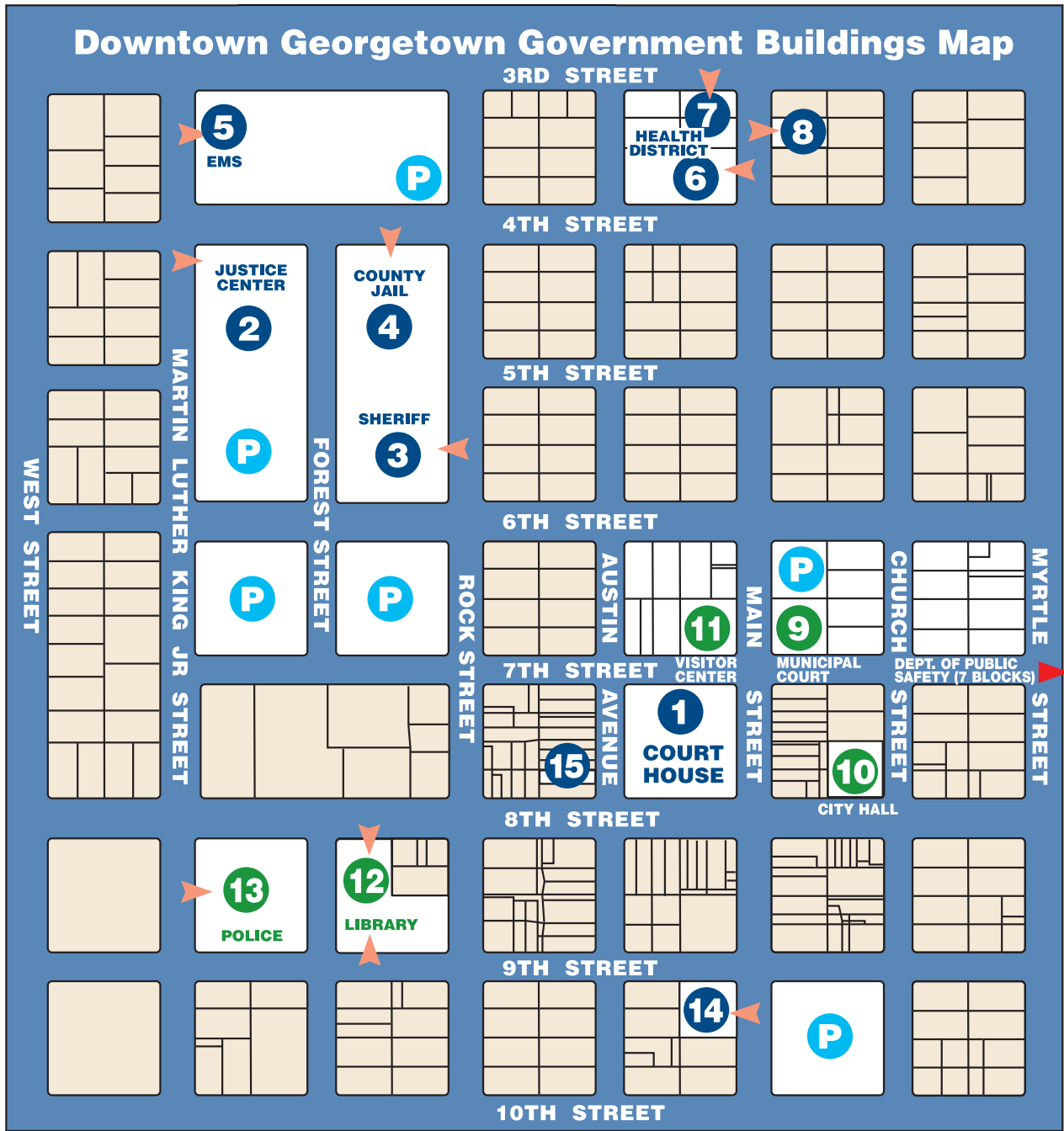


WILLIAMSON COUNTY COURTHOUSE

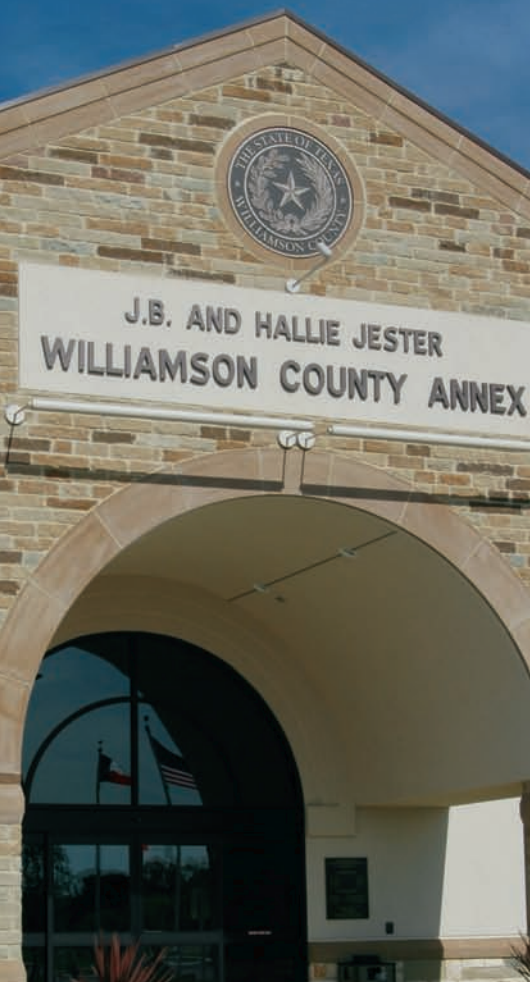
