DECLARATION OF STATE OF DISASTER


WHEREAS, the County of **WILLIAMSON** on the 5th day of **SEPTEMBER, 2011** is under imminent threat of widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property resulting from extraordinary drought conditions, critical weather and wildfire conditions, and the imminent threat of wildfire, and;

WHEREAS, the **Williamson County Judge** has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property and/or the environment;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF **WILLIAMSON COUNTY**:

1. That a state of disaster is declared for Williamson County pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.
2. Pursuant to §418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code, this state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days of the date hereof, unless the same is continued by consent of the Commissioner's Court of **Williamson County, Texas**.
3. Pursuant to §418.108(c) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the County Clerk and the Texas Division of Emergency Management.
4. Pursuant of §418.108(d) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the Williamson County Emergency Management Plan.
5. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
