Welcome Visitors. Relax and enjoy your stay in the great outdoors. Our park provides habitat to a multitude of plants and animals that can be viewed in their natural settings. The park is approximately 300 acres of beautiful rolling countryside with an abundance of pecan and oak trees offering you plenty of shade. Each visit to the park gives an opportunity to understand the significance of this park and our conservation/preservation.

Our amenities include; Day use areas, Hike and Bike Trails, Fishing areas, Bird viewing areas, Playground, Amphitheater, Camping Sites, and Pavilion.

The information presented is to ensure your safety and to protect the environment.

Any violation of park policies, damage to park property, plant or animal wildlife may result in the loss of user privilege without a refund or other consequences in accordance to local law enforcement. State Law prohibits visitors from removing any items from the park.

Williamson County is committed to compliance with the Americans Disabilities Act. If you require special assistance for the use of our facility, prior to your trip please call 512-260-4283 or 512-930-0040.

Rules for Berry Spring Park

- **Park Hours:** Opened to the public 7 a.m. gates close 10 p.m. daily. Park opened year round unless; weather and or road conditions cause closure of the park. For day use you must leave by 10 p.m., gates will be locked. Overnight camping available. (Annual closure 2:00 pm on the second Monday in January for 2 weeks.)
- **Speed limit:** Within the park is 15 mph, Camping areas is 5 mph. No vehicles allowed off of the asphalt. No off road vehicles.
- **Parking:** along creek bed and on grass is prohibited. Park in designated parking spaces ONLY. One vehicle allowed per camp site at Improved sites.
- **Day Use:** Shady picnic tables and benches are located near the water and along the trails.
- **Prohibited Items:** Weapons, Fireworks, Metal Detectors, Digging, and/or removing of artifacts are not allowed at the Park. Avoid cut feet by leaving Glass Containers at home. (Texas Antiquities Code of Texas)
- **Children:** Must have an adult at all times with them and be closely supervised. Adults are considered at least 18 years of age.
- **Dogs:** Must be on a leash no longer than 6 feet and under physical control at all times. Pet owners are responsible for cleanup. If you leave the park, please take your pet with you so barking does not disturb other visitors. Ensure your pet's immunizations are current. Please do your part to preserve this privilege.
- **Trash receptacles:** Campers and Day users are responsible for depositing their trash in trash cans located throughout the park. Also, there is a dumpster located in the parking lot next to the pavilion. Keep your area litter free, including cigarette butts.
- **Fishing:** Strictly Catch & Release. License is required.
- **No Swimming Allowed**

AMENITIES & RATES

- **Pavilions:** To reserve, the fee is \$25.00 (small) and \$35.00 (large) per day. Seating capacity is approximately sixty (60) for the larger one and thirty-two (32) for the smaller one. Electricity fee is \$20, available only at the large pavilion. For safety reasons and protection of the park, please have your activities approved by the Parks Department. For signage and decorations contact the reservation office or onsite park staff for what is permissible.

- **Camping Fees:** accepted at Drop Box if Park Staff is not available. Fill out your envelope completely with all pertinent information and fees; drop in box at Kiosk.
- **Campsites:** If you wish to ensure a site, Improved Campsites are reservable. Reservations are accepted up to one week prior to arrival date. For advance reservations, please call Williamson County Park Office at 512-260-4283 or email us at Parks&Rec@wilco.org. All other sites are first come first serve.
- **Improved Campsites:** \$10 per night; (17) Tents only allowed at sites. No R.V. vehicles permitted on sites. Showers & water available only at the Restrooms. One vehicle per site. Park in the center of the pad, not on the grass. Washing of vehicles and filling of pools is prohibited. Eight people allowed per campsite. Over 8 people, including children, an additional camp site must be purchased. Extra vehicles must park in designated parking lots.
- **Primitive Campsites:** \$6 per night; (10) No water or electric. Sites are located near Berry Creek. Park in designated parking lots only. Vehicles are not allowed at your campsite. All camping for primitive sites are first come first serve. Approximate 1/3 mile walk to campsites from asphalt parking area. Pack it in & pack it out regarding camping supplies. Restrooms, Water and Showers (at Improved Campsites) are available to campers.
- **All Camping:** 14 Day limit in a 30 day period. Non-reservable sites are first come first served. You must physically occupy your site. There are granite tent slabs, BBQ grills, picnic tables and lantern posts at each camp site. Some of the improved sites have Mini shelters. Keep in mind that there are local animals that might get into your garbage and or any eatable items left unattended. Keeps your area litter free, including cigarette butts.
- **Check in time is 2 p.m. / Check out time is 12 noon.** All personal items must be removed.
- **Quiet Hours:** 10 p.m. till 7 a.m. daily. No amplified sound (including radios) or loud noises of any sorts during quiet hours. Strictly enforced.
- **No unattended Campfires.**
- **Ground fire ring:** Available upon request. Park staff must be present during use.
- **Returned checks:** will be fined a \$30 Charge by the W.C. Treasurer Department.
- **Park Employees:** are on site at the park office, grounds, or caretaker's house, if you have any other questions. Please call 512-930-0040 for assistance. (Main office: 512-260-4283)

Fees are collected year round.
