Williamson County is proud to announce it has awarded the Tennis Pro Manager contract to Mr. Ellery McLanahan. Mr. McLanahan earned his bachelor's degree from the University of Wisconsin-Madison, and has been a USPTA certified P1 Tennis Professional since 1995. Ellery McLanahan has an extensive tennis background, including that of a ranked tournament player for over fourteen years as well as serving as Head Professional for fourteen years at the Caswell and South Austin Tennis Centers. As Head Professional, he was responsible for developing various youth and adult programs – leagues, mixers, and private and group lessons – in addition to stringing racquets. The Austin City Council honored Ellery with a Certificate of Congratulations in 2002 for taking a junior team to Nationals in Team Tennis, and in 2006 he received CATA's Junior Pro of the Year award. During the same year, Mr. McLanahan also served as Advisory Staff to the Multi Cultural Programs for the Capital Area Tennis Association.
