

## **WILLIAMSON COUNTY BAIL BOND BOARD MEETING MINUTES**

**January 21, 2022**

The Williamson County Bail Bond Board met in regular session on Friday, January 21, 2022, at 11:30 AM in the County Attorney Training Room, Suite 229 on the second floor of the Justice Center Annex, 405 M.L.K. Blvd., Georgetown, Texas.

4. The election of Judge Stacey Hackenberg as the JP Representative Board Member for 2022 was acknowledged.
5. Acknowledged that Nancy Rister, Bridget Chapman, Cathy Mendoza, Bill Gravell, Rick Kennon, Scott Heselmeyer, Brandy Hallford, Lucas Wilson, and CDR Harder remain as Board Members for 2022.
6. Chairman, Vice-Chairman, and Secretary of the 2022 Bail Bond Board were confirmed following a motion by Bridget Chapman and a second by Cheryl McGirr. Jessica Zak – Chairman, Rick Kennon - Vice Chairman and Scott Heselmeyer - Secretary. The motion carried unanimously with Jessica Zak abstaining to vote.
7. The Minutes from the December 17, 2021 meeting were acknowledged and approved as written.
8. The Treasurer and Sheriff's report for the month of December 2021 was considered and approved following a motion by Cheryl McGirr and a second by Cathy Mendoza. The motion carried unanimously.
