EPCOR builds, owns and operates water, wastewater and stormwater facilities, working in partnership with governments, municipalities and industrial clients. Of approximately 3,500 employees, more than 1,400 are water, wastewater and residuals treatment specialists and engineers. Through tailor-made solutions to address specific needs, EPCOR works with communities across Canada and the United States to build and operate reliable, cost-effective and environmentally sensitive water solutions. EPCOR's work include some of the largest public-private water partnerships (P3) in North America, including the 142-mile Vista Ridge pipeline in Texas, the award-winning City of Regina Wastewater Treatment Plant, and its work on Britannica Mine and restoring the aquatic ecosystem in British Columbia's Howe Sound.

In the United States, EPCOR serves more than 780,000 people across 42 communities and 18 counties in Arizona, New Mexico and Texas, making it one of the largest regulated water utilities in the U.S. Southwest. In addition to regulated water and wastewater service in Arizona and New Mexico, EPCOR delivers wholesale water services and natural gas services in Texas, including Vista Ridge – the nation's largest water P3 serving the San Antonio Water System, and the 130 Pipeline – which delivers water to municipalities in the greater Austin metropolitan area . EPCOR treats and delivers more than 12.675 billion gallons of water each year to communities in the United States and recycles nearly 100% of the effluent it collects, treating it to A+ standards for re-use in irrigation and returning it to the ground for future use. Since 2012, EPCOR has recycled more than 18.2 billion gallons of water, earning it the Water Environment Federation's Utility of the Future Today designation.
