Subject: Williamson County Southeast Loop Update

Construction has begun on the Southeast Loop project just east of the Lakeside Estates neighborhood. Next steps in the project include installation of the new subdivision fencing and utility relocation. The County has provided the HOA with the funds to relocate the subdivision fencing. Private utility relocations are scheduled to begin in front of the Lakeside Estates neighborhood the week of July 26. Work will take place within the new County right-of-way line.

Construction on this segment of the Southeast Loop project began in July 2021 and is expected to last approximately 18 months. In front of the neighborhood, most of the work will involve resurfacing and restriping. At the intersection of CR 138 and SH 130, the pavement will be widened for an additional dedicated right-turn lane from westbound CR 138 to northbound SH 130.
