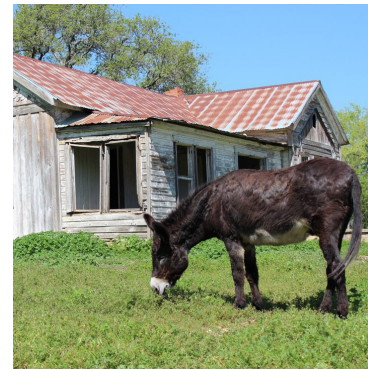


Berry Springs Park and Preserve

Playscape, fishing, 2.5 mile hike/bike trail, camping, covered picnic pavilions

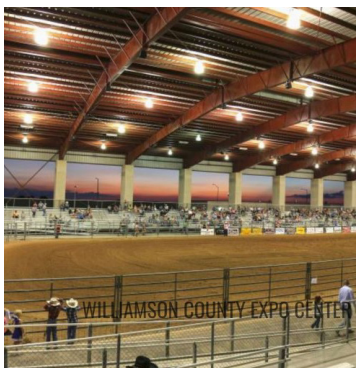
