1. AGREED ORDERS

- a. On all <u>Agreed</u> Orders, please include a phrase "The Court accepts, adopts and renders judgment on the parties agreement as follows:"
- b. The signature block should indicate the parties and their attorneys agree to the FORM and SUBSTANCE of the Agreed Order. Suggested format:

AGREED AS TO BOTH FORM AND SUBSTANCE:

Attorney #1 Signature Block	Client Signature
Attorney #2 Signature Block	Client Signature

2. NON-AGREED ORDERS

a. For court orders that are <u>not</u> agreed, the signature block should be as follows:

1 st Attorney Signature Block
2 nd Attorney Signature Block

AGREED AS TO FORM:

3. ALL ORDERS

- a. All proposed Order must be signed by the attorney submitting the Order for consideration.
- b. The Order must include a full signature block for the submitting attorney.

Beginning June 1, 2016, proposed Orders not submitted in the required format will not be reviewed or considered by Judge Lambeth.
