



Hairy Man Road/Brushy Creek Road Safety Improvements & Great Oaks Drive Bridge

Good afternoon,

Thank you for your continued engagement and interest in the Hairy Man Road/Brushy Creek Road Safety Improvements and Great Oaks Drive Bridge at Brushy Creek projects. The County is committed to continuing our proactive and consistent communication with you as we move into the next phase of these projects.

Work on the Hairy Man Road/Brushy Creek Road Safety Improvements project is expected to begin this week and is anticipated to wrap-up in late 2021. All closures for this project are required to take place Monday – Friday between 9 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. A long-term closure, located between Great Oaks Drive and Sam Bass Road, is expected in segments at some point during construction, and prior notice will be given before this occurs. A minimum of one lane of traffic, as well as access to businesses and residences along the roadway, will be maintained at all times during construction.

As a reminder, this project will improve safety along the rural roadway, now in an urban environment, and provide safer access to park facilities. Project limits include the Hairy Man Road/Brushy Creek roadway between Brushy Bend Drive and Sam Bass Road, a distance of approximately 2.2 miles.

The Great Oaks Drive Bridge at Brushy Creek project is expected to go to construction this spring and wrap-up in fall 2022. We will provide you more information as we approach construction.
