#### What We Do

The Williamson County Attorney's Office is a public prosecutor's office that represents the State of Texas and Williamson County in a wide range of legal matters. The elected County Attorney employs 22 attorneys, 6 investigators, and 25 staff members that practice criminal law, juvenile law, family law, and civil law in the District Courts, County Courts at Law, and Justice Peace Courts in Williamson County, Texas.

#### **Intensive Program**

The High School Intensive Program is a program run by the County Attorney's Office that provides certain students the opportunity to observe, learn, and assist in a Texas prosecutor's office and see first-hand how legal services are provided to the public. Students have the opportunity to:

- Observe real courtroom dockets
- Gain education about local legal services and government
- Take part in supervised case review, analysis, and preparation
- Talk to employees and gain insight about the legal profession
- Participate in mock courtroom exercises

#### **Minimum Qualifications**

Space is limited to high school students who have completed sophomore year. Positions are unpaid, and all students accepted into the program are subject to background checks and other security measures. The following minimum requirements apply:

- Minimum grade point average of B (or equivalent based on school grading scale)
- No more than 3 unexcused absences from school
- Ability to conduct self in professional manner and meet decorum standards normally expected in a courtroom environment
- Completion of teacher recommendation form

#### **Important Dates**

The program duration is five days beginning on either Monday, June 3, 2019 or Monday, July 8, 2019.

Students will be notified via e-mail of acceptance or denial into the program. If accepted, students will be sent a welcome letter and orientation packet no later than one week prior to the start date.
