Welcome Visitors. Relax and enjoy your stay in the great outdoors. Berry Springs provides habitat to a multitude of plants and animals that can be viewed in their natural setting. The park is approximately 300 acres of beautiful rolling countryside with an abundance of pecan and oak trees offering delightful shade. Each visit to the park provides an opportunity to better understand and appreciate its natural, cultural and historic significance.

Park activities include picnicking, relaxing, hiking, biking, fishing, wildlife watching and camping. Park amenities include trails, playground, pavilions, campfire ring, amphitheater, primitive and tent campsites.

Park Rules

- **Park hours** are 7am-10pm daily.
- **Park only in designated areas** to protect the plants and soil. **No parking on the grass.**
- Take only memories and pictures. Please don't disturb or remove any of the park's plants, animals or artifacts.
- Downed dead wood offers food and shelter to wildlife and provides essential nutrients for the soil. **Please do not gather firewood.**
- Please recycle appropriate litter and **deposit trash in trash receptacles.** Leaving no trace of your visit helps the park remain beautiful and reduces the possibility of human/animal conflicts. Please refrain from using water balloons, piñatas and/or confetti type items, silly string, fake flower petals, and chalk on cement.
- Protect pets and wildlife by **keeping pets on leashes**, no longer than 6 feet, and attended at all times.
- Protect all park users and wildlife by **obeying posted speed limits.**
- Broken glass is dangerous. Help everyone enjoy a safe visit by remembering that **no glass containers are allowed.**
- Unless associated with a physical disability, **all other motorized or battery powered transportation is prohibited off roadways and beyond parking areas.** This includes things such as: hoverboards, electric bikes and battery-powered vehicles.
- Fishing license is required. We **practice** catch and release to sustain a healthy fish population for future angler's enjoyment.
- For the safety of others, golfing, firearms/weapons, fireworks and unmanned aircraft systems (e.g. drones) are all prohibited.

Other ways you can help protect Berry Springs Park and Preserve and ensure your visit is safe and enjoyable:

- Ensure your child is closely supervised.
- Use only free-standing hammocks.
- No swimming, boating or other recreational activities in the pond. It is great for fishing though.
- **Keep wildlife wild.** Leave feeding to nature. Feeding wild animals will make them sick and more likely to cause harm to people.
- Don't be afraid of snakes, be aware! They are signs of a healthy environment. If you cross paths with a snake, back away slowly.
- No one wants to step in it; thank you for **picking up after your pet** and properly disposing in trash receptacles.

RESERVATIONS: For advanced reservations for a pavilion, campsite, amphitheater, group fire ring:

- **Call 512-943-1920 Monday thru Friday between 8am-5pm**
- For Friday arrivals, the deadline to reserve a campsite is Noon on Friday.
- Prior approval is required for bounce houses, trailer grills, game trucks, etc.

CAMPING

- If arriving without a campsite reservation and campsites are available: (1) fill out envelope completely; (2) insert appropriate fee and deposit in drop box at the information kiosk; (3) tear off the numbered receipt that is on the lip of the envelope and display it on the dash of your vehicle. This identifies you as a paid customer when using campground facilities and when the park has closed at curfew.
- 14-day limit in a 30-day period.
- Non-reserved sites are first come, first serve. You must physically occupy your site.
- Campers under the age of 17 must be accompanied by an adult for the length of stay or have a minor's release form on file that is authorized by a parent or guardian.
- **Check in time is 2 pm, check out time is 12 noon.**
- **Quiet Hours:** 10pm-7am. Respect your neighbors and celebrate nature's night noises. Please no amplified sound (including radios) or loud noises of any sort during quiet hours.
- **Campfires** should not be left unattended. **Firewood** is available (donations accepted) located by tent campsite #15 and in the primitive campground near site #4.
- **Primitive Tent Campsites:** No water or electric. Sites are located near Berry Creek. Park in designated parking lots only. **Vehicles are not allowed at your campsite.** Approximate 1/3 mile walk to campsites from asphalt parking area. Pack it in and pack it out policy for camping supplies. Restrooms, water and showers (at Tent Campsites) are available to campers.
- **Tent Campsites:** No electric. Tents only allowed at sites. **No RV's permitted.** Restroom, water and showers are available to campers. Washing of vehicles and filling of pools is prohibited. One vehicle per site. Extra vehicles must park in designated parking areas.
