Please note the following as it relates to the Williamson County Parks Department:

[Berry Springs Park & Preserve](#)

- Open to the public 7am-10pm for day-use only.
- Overnight camping is permitted. Currently only 75% of total number of campsites are available for use.
- Pavilions are available for reservations at a 75% occupancy.

[Champion Park](#)

- Open to the public 7am-10pm for day-use only.
- Pavilions are available for reservations. Maximum occupancy is 10 people.

[Expo Center](#)

- Overnight RV camping is permitted. Currently only 75% of total number of campsites are available for use.

[Southwest Williamson County Regional Park](#)

- Open to the public 7:30 am to 10 pm for day-use only.
- Pavilions are available for reservations at 75% occupancy.
- [Cedar Rock Railroad](#) is open at 75% capacity.

[River Ranch County Park](#)

- CLOSED to the public while under construction. No public access allowed.

[Twin Lakes Park](#)

- Open to the public 7am-10pm for day-use only.

Please be reminded:
