



Basic Addressing Guidelines

Williamson county and the cities within have developed the below basic addressing guidelines for development within the county boundaries. These guidelines are applicable to all cities within Williamson County. Beyond this, please contact the individual city for further instruction.

Roadway Naming

- If the roadway is the continuation of an existing road it should keep the same name, even if it crosses city lines
- Directionals (North, South, East, and West) can't be used as part of the road name (Ex: N. South St.)
- Check with the individual city or county for restricted or reserved street names

Single Family Addressing

- Addressing will be assigned by the city or county in which the development is located
- Townhomes and Condos will be addressed based on layout; if they appear as single family detached homes they will be addressed as single family homes without unit numbers. If they are attached via a shared wall they will be addressed using a single main address number with individual unit numbers
- Duplexes will be addressed using sequential numbers, no letters will be used (Ex: 100 & 102, skip 4, 106 & 108)
 - A & B may be found historically but all future developments of duplexes will be assigned using sequential numbers
- RV Parks will have one address for the park and each spot will consist of a unit number
- Mobile Home Parks – refer to the individual city for addressing standards

Multi - Family Addressing

- Addressing will be assigned by the city or county in which the development is located
- Apartments will have one address per complex; Unit numbers will be assigned starting counter clockwise - no letters are allowed

Commercial Addressing

- If there are multiple suites or buildings at one location, suite numbers may not contain letters and should allow for the possibility of later building modification (Ex: A two unit building may be addressed as 1234 S. Main St. Unit 101 & Unit 110)
- Consult the appropriate city for commercial addressing standards as this differs between cities
